### **Part I: The Prophetic Mantle Over North Carolina**

\*Just as North Carolina has led the South in revival, it has also led it in evil. In order to clean out the well of the Tar Heel State, we must discover the ancient root of sin that has kept her from coming into the fullness of her destiny: Global End-Time Revival!

- a.) Carolina Charter 1663: First Governing document that gave access to the enemy in Carolina.
- b.) North Carolina becomes the Gateway or "Bethel" for the entire South.
- c.) Carolina Charter lays a foundation for hatred, prejudice, violence, and slavery for South U.S.

### **Part II: North Carolinas Spiritual Generals: A.B. Crumpler and G.B. Cashwell**

- a.) Rev. A.B. Crumpler: North Carolinas Apostle of Holiness

Established Holiness Movement in North Carolina.

Held Massive Tent Revivals all over Eastern North Carolina

Broke through racial/denominational barriers

Planted over 30 churches throughout Eastern North Carolina

United the Free-Will Baptist Cape Fear Conference with Methodists and Presbyterian churches.

Co-founded the International Pentecostal Holiness Church (Today has 2 million members)

Trained up/Equipped hundreds of Evangelists/Pastors/Teachers

Mayor of Clinton, N. C.

Justice of Peace

- b.) Rev. G.B. Cashwell: "The Apostle of Pentecost to the South"

Established the Baptism with the Holy Spirit in North Carolina and the entire Southern U.S.

Planted dozens of Churches

Brought 12 major denominations into the Pentecostal Movement including:

Assemblies of God. Today has 56 million members

Church of God (Cleveland, T.N.). Today has 7 million members

Church of God of Prophecy. Today has 1.5 million members

Congregational Holiness Church. Today has 25,000 members

International Pentecostal Church of Christ. Today has 5,000 members.

International Pentecostal Holiness Church. Today has 2 million members.

Pentecostal Free Will Baptist. Today has 30,000 members.

\*Today 70 million Pentecostal believing Christians can trace their roots directly back to G.B. Cashwell, and the revival he lead in Dunn, North Carolina, during January 1907.
